Making a Statement in Schools...



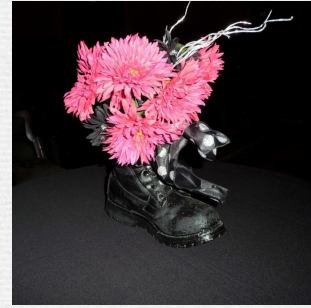
One of Statement's long-term goals is to be an integral part of the school health curriculum and teach our dating abuse prevention program during school hours. We have made our first

leap toward that goal this spring. In May, Mead High School invited Statement to teach a 2-day dating abuse class to more than 120 freshmen and sophomore students.
